



## MIDDLE YEARS PROGRAMME (MYP) INTERNAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Middle Years Programme Internal Scholarship is awarded to a promising **returning** student **entering Grade 6** in September 2012. This 5-year scholarship will be awarded to a student who demonstrates academic excellence; a minimum 90% (4+) average contributes to school life; and has shown exceptional understanding and practice of the International Baccalaureate Learner Profile.

The total value of this 5-year scholarship is \$7000. The scholarship will be applied yearly as a tuition reduction of \$1000 for the first 3 years (Grades 6, 7, 8) and an increase in tuition reduction for Grade 9 and Grade 10 equalling the value of \$2000 for each of these years.

### APPLICATION PROCESS

All areas of the application process must be complete in order for a student to be considered for the scholarship. **Completed applications forms must be submitted to Dana Lynn Borschewski, Director of Admissions by 4 p.m. on Friday, November 18, 2011.** In addition, all applicants will be expected to submit a written composition to be written on **Saturday, November 26 from 11:00-12:00** at Elmwood. Finally all applicants will participate in an interview with members of our scholarship committee.
