



SENIOR SCHOOL INTERNAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Senior School Internal Scholarship is awarded to a promising **returning** student **entering Grade 9** in September 2012. This 4-year scholarship will be awarded to a student who demonstrates academic excellence, a minimum 90% average, contributes to school life, and has demonstrated positive leadership ability through her involvement in school life and/or the greater community.

The total value of this scholarship is \$8000. The scholarship will be applied yearly as a tuition reduction of \$2000 for each year of Senior School.

APPLICATION PROCESS

All areas of the application process must be complete in order for a student to be considered for the scholarship. **Completed application forms must be submitted to Dana Lynn Borschewski, Director of Admissions by 4 p.m. on Friday, November 18, 2011.** In addition, all applicants will be expected to submit a written essay to be written on **Saturday, November 26 from 11:00-12:00** at Elmwood. Finally all applicants will participate in an interview with members of our scholarship committee.
