



SUMMA SUMMARUM SCHOLARSHIP

The Summa Summarum Scholarship is awarded to an outstanding **returning** student entering Grade 11 in September 2012 who will be enrolled and committed to completing the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme. This prestigious 2-year scholarship will be awarded to a student who demonstrates academic excellence and has achieved a minimum overall 90% average, who contributes to school life, and who appreciates the benefits of and understands the expected rigour and commitment level of the IB Diploma Programme.

The total value of this scholarship is \$10,000. The scholarship will be applied yearly as a tuition reduction of \$4500 for Grade 11 and Grade 12. An additional, \$1000 scholarship will be awarded to the student to put toward university tuition if a student achieves a minimum of score 38 on overall IB results.

APPLICATION PROCESS

All areas of the application process must be complete in order for a student to be considered for the scholarship. **Completed application forms must be submitted to Dana Lynn Borschewski, Director of Admissions by 4 p.m. on Friday, November 18, 2011.** In addition, all applicants will be expected to submit a written composition to be written on **Saturday, November 26 from 11:00-12:00** at Elmwood. Finally all applicants will participate in an interview with members of our scholarship committee.
