An exciting French Immersion Experience for Grades 6, 7 and 8

March 5th - March 14th, 2011

Elmwood School is delighted to announce a trip to France for students in Grades 6, 7 and 8 during March Break 2011. The purpose of the trip is to provide our students with a true French immersion experience and an opportunity to learn firsthand about France's rich history and culture.

The trip will begin with six days at the world-renowned Maison Claire Fontaine, a French language school in beautiful Magny. During their stay, our students will be fully immersed in the French language, while enjoying lively classroom instruction, archery, sculpting, mosaic workshops, bowling, visits to Medieval Chateau Guedelon, the Auchan Trail, and Vermenton outdoor food market. Elmwood faculty will accompany the girls at all times.

The trip will conclude with two days in Paris, staying at the historic, 4-star Hotel de Castiglione on the rue de Fauborg St Honore. The girls will participate in French-language tours of Paris, the Louvre, and Chateau Versailles.

The cost of the trip is \$2939 (plus insurance) and is all-inclusive except for the two lunches in Paris. This price is based on a minimum of 20 participants.
