Dear Parents,

I am excited to send you the confirmation information for a small group of the Elmwood Rowing Crew to attend the Head of the Charles Regatta in Boston, Massachusetts on October 21– 23, 2011. Sophia Caragianis, Emily Featherstone, Emmie Page and Sam Peters have been selected to compete at this regatta.

Rowers will travel to and from the regatta with their parents, and stay at the Constitution Inn in Boston. It is located at 150 Third Avenue, Boston, MA, 02129. (1-800-495-9622). The reservation is currently under the name “Derek Howe” and each family will need to call to confirm and pay for their own room. Students must have passports to attend this regatta, as well as purchase their own travel insurance.

Unfortunately I will not be able to attend, however, Derek Howe, Andrew Howard and Jeanne Harfield will all be coaching at this regatta and it is understood that each family will have at least one parent accompanying each girl.

There is a travel time of approximately 7 ½ hours. Students are expected to arrive at the race course on Friday October 21st in time to be able to practice on the course (the course is only open on Friday for practice). You will be informed of the time closer to the date of the regatta. There will be a crew dinner either Friday or Saturday evening. The race time for both doubles will be at approximately 12:03 p.m. on Sunday October 23rd. After the regatta, rowers will help load the boats onto the trailer, and families will be able to head home immediately after.

Please note that each rower will be billed approximately \$135 USD to cover the costs of competing at this regatta.

CONSENT TO PARTICIPATE & TERMS OF PARTICIPATION

By my signature below, I give my daughter of SLG/Homeroom _____ permission to attend the Head of the Charles Regatta at Boston University Boathouse, October 21-23, 2011.

I understand that all of Elmwood School's rules and policies (see Handbook) as well as any rules and directives established by those leading the trip remain in full force and effect for the duration of the trip.

By my signature below, I acknowledge and agree that I am solely responsible for any costs arising out of my daughter's breach of any of Elmwood School's rules and policies and/or any rules and directives established by those leading the trip and the resultant disciplinary actions, if any, whether occurring prior to or during the trip.

By my signature below, I further acknowledge and agree that in the event that my daughter breaches any of Elmwood School's rules and policies and/or any rules and directives established by those leading the trip while on the trip, Elmwood School may in its absolute discretion require that my daughter immediately return home and any expenses related to such a return (including without limitation travel, including travel of an adult to accompany my daughter, and any outstanding trip expenses) will be my sole responsibility.

RELEASE AND INDEMNITY

In consideration of my daughter being permitted to participate in the Head of the Charles Regatta ("the trip"), I do for myself, my daughter, my spouse and our respective heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, agree as follows:

I acknowledge and accept that participation in the trip may expose my daughter to unspecified risks and hazards, which are inherent in such trips, including without limitation, the method of transportation for the trip, my daughter's participation in all travel activities and programs incidental to the trip, including without limitation, participation in tours, cultural events, athletic events, sightseeing, recreational and entertainment events, whether or not they have been fully explained to me in advance, including without limitation, the use by my daughter of various methods of transportation, all of which I expressly and voluntarily assume.

Furthermore, I acknowledge and accept that Elmwood's staff rowing coach cannot attend the trip and I agree by my signature below that non-staff coaches Derek Howe, Andrew Howard and Jeanne Harfield (the "volunteers") will provide rowing supervision and coaching to my daughter during the trip, although the volunteers will not be responsible for my daughter when she is not rowing. In that regard, I acknowledge and accept that my daughter will not be under the direct supervision and control of the volunteers at all times during the trip (including but not limited to during the drive to and from Boston and overnights at the hotel). As such, I agree that the conduct of our daughter during unsupervised times and any consequences flowing from such conduct is solely the responsibility of my daughter and/or myself.

I further acknowledge and accept that as the trip is to the United States, I am responsible for purchasing all travel and/or medical insurance which my daughter or I may require for the purposes of the trip, and that I am responsible for ensuring that my daughter has a valid passport to permit her to enter the United States.

By my signature below, I do for myself, my daughter, my spouse and our respective heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, hereby RELEASE, WAIVE AND FOREVER DISCHARGE Elmwood School Inc. and its

respective officers, directors partners, agents, employees, servants, representatives, successors and assigns (“the Releasees”) OF AND FROM any and all actions, causes of actions, complaints, demands and claims whatsoever in existence prior to on or after the date hereof whether in law or in equity, in respect of death, injury, loss or damage to my daughter’s person or my person or property HOWSOEVER CAUSED, arising or to arise by reason of my daughter’s participation in the activities contemplated herein except to the extent that same are directly caused by the gross negligence of Elmwood School Inc. or its respective officers, partners, agents, employees, servants, representatives, successors and assigns. I FURTHER UNDERTAKE TO HOLD AND SAVE HARMLESS AND AGREE TO INDEMNIFY all the aforesaid from and against any and all liability incurred by any or all of them arising as a result of or in any way connected to my daughter’s participation in the activities contemplated herein.

By my signature below, I also agree and undertake not to make any claim or take any proceedings against the Releasees set out above, or any other person or corporation which might claim contribution or indemnity under the provisions of any statute or otherwise from the Releasees set out above.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL CONSENT

In the event of an emergency, Elmwood School requires parental consent in order to consent to the medical treatment or surgery of the student. Elmwood School will use reasonable efforts to contact the parent(s) prior to consenting to medical treatment for the student and the parent(s) acknowledge and agree that the need for an immediate decision regarding medical treatment for the student may make such contact impossible.

Accordingly, I, by my signature below, hereby authorize and give my express consent to the Head of Elmwood School, or her delegate, to act in loco parentis and in that capacity to consent to medical treatment or surgery for the student based on the advice of the attending physician who considers immediate medical treatment or surgery to be a necessity.

In addition, by my signature below, I hereby authorize and give my express consent to the Head of Elmwood School, or her delegate, to seek and obtain any and all medical interventions that may be reasonably required to ensure the safety and well being of my daughter while on the trip.
