

## CAMP ELMWOOD 2010 PACKING LIST

Please take some time to review this packing list. While we are at camp students should dress for outdoor recreational activities and should bring clothing appropriate for all types of weather.

### **Clothing**

- Shorts (No Short Shorts) - (2)
- Long pants (2)
- T-shirt (2)
- Sweatshirt (2)
- Pajamas
- Socks (3)
- Underwear (4)
- Rainwear
- Hat
- Toque and Mitts
- Running shoes
- Flip Flops or Sandals
- Towel
- Bathing suit (No string bikinis)

### **Optional Items**

- Plaid Shirt
- House Colour Headband/t-shirt

\*Note: Temperatures at Camp Kandalore tend to be lower than in the city, particularly in the evening. Make sure you pack enough warm clothing.

### **Bedding**

- Sleeping Bag
- Pillow and pillow case
- Single Fitted Sheet

### **Toiletries**

- Washcloth
- Toothbrush and paste
- Soap and Shampoo
- Hand towel
- Deodorant
- Sunscreen

### **Miscellaneous**

- Small flashlight
- Insect repellent
- Camp fire instruments, songs and stories
