**Test Date: Saturday, October 15**

**What is the PSAT?**

- The PSAT is a multiple-choice standardized test administered by the College Board and the National Merit Scholarship Program. It is also known as the National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (NMSQT).
- The test is composed of three sections: Math, Critical Reading, and Writing.

**Who should write it?**

- Anyone in Grade 10 or 11 who plans to go to an American college or university would benefit from writing this test as practice for the SAT.

**When is it being held?**

- **Saturday, October 15, 2010 - 8:00 a.m. -12:00 noon**

**How much does it cost?**

- To cover the costs of the tests plus postage and handling, students will be charged **\$25.00**. Students should bring either a money order or a cheque for \$25.00 to Ms. Clarke in the Guidance Office. Cheques should be made out to Elmwood School.
- You will receive the publication ***Official Student Guide to the PSAT*** only if you have paid. A maximum of 20 students will be able to write on this date, so please be sure to submit your cheque to Ms. Clarke **no later than Tuesday, October 11.**
- The **Official Student Guide to the PSAT** contains information on the test itself and gives you sample questions that will help you are prepare for the PSAT. It also gives additional information about the National Merit Scholarship program.
